

# **Golf Course Policies**

## **Hours of Play**

- Tee Times are available in ten (10) minute intervals starting at 8:00 am during the prime golf season of May through September.
- Starting tee times may vary during the colder months (March, April, October, November, and December) based on weather and potential frost delays.
  - o <u>If the temperature is 40 degrees or lower, we recommend that you call the Golf Shop prior to coming to the Club.</u>
- The Club is closed to Members on Mondays throughout the year. The course is reserved on Tuesday mornings until 11:00 am for the Ladies S.W.in.G. league.
- Tee times are recommended to ensure that the golf course is available pending Member Tournaments or other special events.

### **Golf Guest Policies**

- Members are encouraged to bring guests to play golf at the Club.
- Guests are permitted to play golf with the member:
  - After 10:00 am on Saturday and Sunday,
  - After 11:00 am on Tuesday, and
  - Any time Wednesday through Friday
- A golf guest is limited to no more than six (6) rounds per year at the Club's accompanied guest rate, either as the guest of said Member or as the guest of any other Member.
- Members must register all golf guests in the Golf Shop prior to play.
- Members are responsible for ensuring golf guests follow all policies and procedures while at the Club.
- Members may have up to seven (7) guests on the golf course at one time.
- All guest policies are subject to change at the discretion of the Head Golf Professional and Club management.

## **Social Golf Member Policies**

- Social Golf Members are limited to eight (8) rounds of golf per year.
- Social Golf Members are permitted to make tee times:
  - After 10:00 am on Saturday and Sunday,
  - o After 11:00 am on Tuesday, and
  - Any time Wednesday through Friday.
- If multiple people in a Social Golf Member's family play during a scheduled tee time, that is considered one (I) of the Social Golf Member's eight (8) rounds.
- Once those eight (8) rounds have been exhausted, Social Golf Members are required to upgrade to a Full Golf category in order to receive additional golf course access during the calendar year.

## **Driving Range and Practice Facility**

- The practice facilities will open at the same time the Golf Shop opens and will close at the posted times based on the weather and subject to the hours of operation allowing the staff ample time to clean the range.
- Usage of the driving range is restricted to Golf Members and Social Golf Members.
  - Social Resident Members do not have access to the golf course or practice facility unless they are a guest of a Golf Member.

## **Golf Cart Regulations**

- All golf carts are required to follow prescribed routes (such as cart path only) as designated by the signs posted on #1 tee or as instructed by the Golf Shop.
- Members and guests are required to have a state issued driver's license to drive a golf cart on the course at Signature.
- Golf carts are to be used on the golf course by golfers only.
  - The Club does not permit spectators, pedestrians, or tours of the golf course unless previously approved by the Head Golf Professional or Club management.
  - Exception the cart path that crosses #13 tee and runs behind #12 green that connects Signature I to Signature II.

## **Course and Greens**

## A Message from Your Greens Committee

The primary focus of the Greens Committee is the golf course itself – the daily/weekly condition and presentation of the golf course to our members and guests and to a lesser extent, the longer-term vision of potential modifications/enhancements to the golf course in the years to come, all within the typical constraints of a corporate owned club. The Greens Committee will be the voice of our Superintendent, Curt Lally to the members to communicate information regarding what is expected of members and guests about taking care of our golf course (the "rules" if you will), what projects Curt and his team are working on and have planned in the coming months, and relevant current conditions and circumstances that may impact the daily/weekly golf course conditions. Finally, the Greens Committee will liaise with the Tournament and Handicap Committees when appropriate for the betterment of the golf experience for our members and guests.

The Greens Committee has met twice in the spring of 2023 on May 23rd and June 20th with the following points being the primary points of emphasis to be communicated to the members:

- 1. "Player ready" golf course daily, particularly on weekends and holidays the committee defined this as mowed and rolled greens, fresh cups (painted white if possible) and fully raked and groomed sand traps at a minimum. We trust members have noticed that Curt and his staff have focused on this as his plan is to mow 5-6 times a week, roll 4-5 times a week, rake, and groom traps at least 5-6 times a week and cut fresh cups 4-5 times a week.
- 2. Reclaim the golf course from the wetlands Those of you who have been around for years will attest to the wetlands creep that has occurred over the years and the amount of playable area we have lost. Curt and his team have focused very hard on reclaiming many areas of the course and have a plan to continue to maintain a reasonable height of the wetland areas on the course and to keep the edges maintained to avoid additional creep.
- 3. Condition and safety of bridges many of our bridges have deteriorated over the years and will require some level of repair which is a longer-term, off-season project that will be discussed at the corporate level. In the short-term, Curt and his team over the coming weeks will be evaluating all of the bridges for potential safety concerns (i.e. nails, slick surfaces when wet, etc.) and plans to install a traction product on certain bridges to improve safety.

- 4. Penalty area/OB marking The committee discussed the importance of enhancing the penalty area and out-of-bounds marking of the golf course and will liaise with the tournament committee and the professional staff on this to ensure consistency and regularity of marking the golf course. Members should understand that stakes are visual indicators of the approximate location of a penalty area or out of bounds line. The actual painted lines represent the exact location of the hazard line or out of bounds line.
- 5. Golf course signage The committee also discussed the need for additional signage on the golf course indicating where cart traffic is restricted, where carts should enter and exit fairways and for drop areas, etc.
- 6. Sand Trap conditions/drainage We call attention to the complete reconstruction of the greenside bunker on #16 to improve drainage. This was an initial test project for Curt and his team to evaluate the longer-term requirements to improve the drainage in our traps. The Arcis Corporate agronomist team has toured the course and was shown this successful project. Curt and his team plan to work with the corporate team to develop a long-term plan to improve drainage in traps throughout the golf course. This is no small task and will take some time, so we ask for patience from members on this point.
- 7. Expectations of all golf members and their guests The committee spent significant time discussing what should be communicated to the membership regarding expected conduct, including that of guests. Following are the basic things we can all do to help Curt and his staff present the golf course to us and our guests in the best condition possible:
  - a. Always check-in with the Pro Shop before teeing off.
  - b. Next and most important leave the golf course in better condition than how you found it
    - i. This starts on the first tee box be sure to pick up your tee even if broken and any others on the tee box. Do this on every hole and do not leave tees in the ground as they damage mower blades.
    - ii. Fill your divot with sand (or replace turf if intact). We have all gotten very frustrated to hit a perfect drive and then find it in a divot in the fairway. Fill your divot and 2-3 more. If we all do this, the problem will be solved.
    - iii. Rake sand traps Same as above we have all hit a shot into the trap only to find it in an unraked footprint. Rake the sand that you have disturbed like a professional caddy. Make sure you leave the area in better condition than you found it and don't be afraid to rake areas that someone else ignored. Rakes should be left in bunkers aligned in direction of play.
    - iv. Fix your ball mark (PROPERLY see the signs posted around the club and the attached document. We understand sometimes it is hard to find your own ball mark. Make it a habit to fix at least 2-3 on every green including your own.

- c. Golf carts should always remain on the cart path on all par 3 holes from tee to green. This is obvious to most of us but needs to be restated so everyone understands this expectation.
- d. Golf carts should generally be kept IN THE FAIRWAY and OUT OF THE ROUGH. Obviously except when conditions require cart path only, unless otherwise restricted (#16 for example) carts should enter the fairway from the cart path at the marked spot and should stay in the fairway and out of the rough as the hole is played ultimately exiting the fairway at the marked spot near the green. Curt and his staff are working hard to improve the rough areas and keeping carts out of the rough will help improve the condition and consistency of the rough over time.
- e. Golf carts should never be driven near green Carts should always be driven no closer than 30-40 feet (10-15 strides) to the greens and should NEVER be driven in the rough up near any greens most notable violations of this are generally the left side of #2, the left and right side of #14, etc.

The Greens Committee plans to meet approximately monthly throughout the year and will continue periodic communications to the membership. We welcome all feedback and are happy to provide additional clarity on any of these points as may be needed.

- When a Member makes a hole-in-one at Signature, all Members of the Hole-in-One Club are invited to come to the Club and enjoy a complementary drink to celebrate the ace.
- The Member who made the hole-in-one also receives a personalized plaque to commemorate the accomplishment.

# **Handicaps**

## A Message from Your Handicap Committee

Dated: July 20, 2023

The Signature of Solon Handicap Committee is here to communicate, educate, and ensure that Signature is a healthy club, where competitions are run with everyone on an equal playing field. As previously communicated, our goal is to have every member post their scores in GHIN after every eligible round played, and to ensure they are posted correctly. In addition to communication and education, we are also auditing to ensure that members who compete in golf events and leagues at Signature of Solon are posting scores appropriately. When audits indicate that Signature of Solon members with a GHIN handicap do not post a score for a scheduled round, the committee will review and may post a score of par + 50% of the members course handicap for the round.

We realize that there are situations where you may not be able to post a score. This would usually happen when playing a format that is not eligible for posting, e.g., scrambles, playing less than 7 holes, or playing alone. If this is the case, please contact Dan Banks to discuss the situation. This will have no impact for members who do not maintain a GHIN handicap for competitive purposes.

As always, please reach out to any of us on the committee if you have any questions regarding posting scores.

## **Northern Ohio Golf Association**

Signature of Solon Country Club is a member of the Northern Ohio Golf Association (NOGA). To allow our Golf Members to participate in the many tournaments throughout our district, we must adhere to all NOGA rules and regulations. NOGA is part of the USGA's GHIN system, a stroke control system for handicapping purposes. These procedures will also help your Golf Committee and Handicap Committee establish equitable handicaps for our Club events. The annual handicap fee for all Members is \$40 + tax and billed in the May Statement.

## **Handicaps in Tournament Play**

Unless otherwise stated, handicaps for tournament play will be determined 2 days prior to the start of any tournament subject to changes as determined solely by the pro shop in consult with the Signature of Solon Tournament and Handicap committees.

## White Tees in Tournament Play

Unless otherwise stated on the following tournament specific pages, all tournament tees are played from the blue tees. However, white tees will be available in tournament play (except for Member / Guest Invitational) and where stated, for all men aged 70 and older OR for all men whose age + handicap is 85 or more. (the "White Tee Rule")

## **Equitable Stroke Control**

Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) is the system which limits the number of strokes a golfer may report for handicap purposes. With the launch of the new World Handicap System in January 2020, the maximum score you can record for handicapping purposes is **NET** DOUBLE BOGEY. If you are out of a hole and pick up your ball to speed up play, mark down the score you most likely would have made. For handicap purposes, you are required to adjust your hole score (actual or probable) when it is higher than the maximum score you can post for that hole. There is no limit to the number of holes on which you can adjust your score.

\*\*\* To simplify this process, enter your score into the GHIN app hole-by-hole. The GHIN app will make the necessary adjustments. \*\*\*

# **Posting Scores**

After completing 18 holes, the player must enter his or her adjusted score on the GHIN mobile app. In addition, scores from other courses must also be entered into the computer for your handicap computation, using your adjusted score and the course slope and rating. If you have any questions concerning any of the above procedures, please ask one of the Golf Professionals for assistance.

All 9-hole scores (with 7 or more holes played) as well as all 18-hole scores (with 13 or more holes played) are required to be posted. If you play at least 7 or 13 holes, the remaining unplayed holes (9-hole or 18-hole score, respectively), for handicap purposes shall be recorded as par plus any handicap strokes that you are entitled to receive on the unplayed holes.

With the implementation of the new World Handicap System in 2020, handicap indexes are updated <u>daily</u> instead of twice a month on the 1st and 15th. Since the maximum score you can post on any given hole is now net double bogey, it is important that you confirm your handicap index on the day you played prior to posting your score.

It is important that you post your score with the proper date and course.

The Handicap Committee is fully aware the Club is to be used and enjoyed by the Members and the above-mentioned rule will not apply if a golfer enjoys a few holes while not playing under The Rules of Golf (i.e. practicing while hitting extra shots, etc.). The stroke control and posting procedures have been designed to account for all 9- and 18-hole rounds from the beginning of the golf season to the end of the golf season.

April 1st through October 31st is the active posting season in Northeast Ohio as defined by NOGA. You cannot post scores for handicap purposes for rounds played in a northern climate between November 1st and March 31st.

## **Points Standard**

#### Club Championship & Senior Club Championship

• 4 flights; flight placement determined by index; ties split points except 1st (winner of flight if sudden death).

#### Signature Cup, Buddy-Buddy, and Bonnie-Clyde Match Play

- Brackets of 16 teams to facilitate 4 rounds; points determined by advancement in rounds, except for finals (1st vs 2nd).
- Seeding; past winner (if same flight and same person / team) gets #1 seed, everyone else by index / team index; minimize "byes" by "filling up" brackets.

#### Signature Ryder Cup

• 3 teams of 16 players; all members within the teams gets the same points depending on team's placement.

#### Spring Member/Member and Burgundy Coat

- 4 flights; top 2 in each flight advance to shootout 8 total; Holes #'s 1, 2, 9, 18 (eliminate 2, 2, 2, 1).
- If 5 flights; top 2 in each flight advance to shootout 10 total; Holes #'s 1, 2, 9, 18 (eliminate 4, 2, 2, 1); points would be for 7th to 10th (first 4 eliminated receives 50 points); 3rd place in flights receives 40 points (1st and 2nd are in shootout).

#### **Member / Guest**

- 10 flight winners and 2 wild cards advance to shootout split into 2 groups; Group I #'s I, 2, 3 and Group 2 #'s I3, I4, I5 (eliminate 2, I, I) with 2 teams in each group advancing to hole 9 and hole I8 (eliminate 2 and I)
- This format will produce the clear places for points and then each of the 2nd and 3rd place flights receives points; since we have 2 wild cards, the two wild card teams receive the shootout points and not flight points (no double points).
- Holes 1, 2, 3 and 13, 14, 15 produces 3 holes with consistent pars (4, 4, 3). Since 15 is the most difficult par 3, the lower index flight should be in group 2. The two wild cards should be in the same group as their flight winners so the group split will need to be determined. Flight winner and wild card tie breaker is chip-off.
