Golf Shop: Hours of Operation

January thru March

- Tuesday thru Saturday
- 9:00 am to 4:00 pm

April thru October

- Tuesday thru Sunday
- 8:00 am to 6:00 pm

November and December

- Tuesday thru Sunday
- 9:00 am to 5:00 pm

The Golf Shop is closed on Mondays except for holidays & golf outings.

Driving Range: Hours of Operation

The Driving Range will open one hour prior to the first tee time and is closed November through March.

Please see below for times of closure.

Golf Course Policies

Dress Code

PROPER GOLF ATTIRE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PLAYERS

- Non-collared shirts, tank tops, halter-tops, cutoffs, sweatpants, tennis or other athletic shorts, and bathing suits are not permitted on the golf course or practice facilities.
- For gentlemen, shirts with collars or mock collars and sleeves, slacks, and golf shorts no shorter than one hand length above the top of the knee are considered proper attire.
- For ladies, slacks, capris, skirts, dresses, blouses, shirts with or without collars, and shirts with or without sleeves are considered proper attire. Skirts, skorts, and shorts shall be no shorter than one hand length above the top of the knee.

Hours of Play

- Tee Times are available in ten (10) minute intervals.
- Starting tee times may vary during the colder months (March, April, October, November, and December) based on weather and potential frost delays.
 - *If the temperature is 40 degrees or lower, we recommend that you call the Golf Shop prior to coming to the Club.*
- The Club is closed to Members on Mondays throughout the year. The course is reserved on Tuesday mornings until 11:00 am for the Ladies S.W.in.G. league.
- Tee times are recommended to ensure that the golf course is available pending Member Tournaments or other special events.

Golf Guest Policies

- Members are encouraged to bring guests to play golf at the Club.
- Guests are permitted to play golf with the member:
 - After 10:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.
 - Any time Tuesday through Friday

-
- A golf guest is limited to no more than six (6) rounds per year at the Club's accompanied guest rate, either as the guest of said Member or as the guest of any other Member.
 - Members must register all golf guests in the Golf Shop prior to play.
 - Members are responsible for ensuring golf guests follow all policies and procedures while at the Club.
 - Members may have up to seven (7) guests on the golf course at one time.
 - All guest policies are subject to change at the discretion of the Director of Golf and Club management.

Driving Range and Practice Facility

- The practice facilities will open one hour prior to the first tee time and will close at the posted times based on the weather and subject to the hours of operation allowing the staff ample time to clean the range.
- Usage of the driving range is restricted to Golf Members and their guests.
 - **Social Resident Members do not have access to the golf course or practice facility unless they are a guest of a Golf Member.**
 - When utilizing the "short game area" please do not chip balls across the cart path onto the practice green. Also, do not hit full shots from the "short game area" onto the range.

Golf Cart Regulations

- All golf carts are required to follow prescribed routes (such as cart path only) as designated by the signs posted on #1 tee or as instructed by the Golf Shop.
- Members and guests are required to have a state issued driver's license to drive a golf cart on the course at Signature.
- Golf carts are to be used on the golf course by golfers only.
 - The Club does not permit spectators, pedestrians, or tours of the golf course unless previously approved by the Director of Golf or Club management.
 - *Exception – the cart path that crosses #13 tee and runs behind #12 green that connects Signature I to Signature II.*

Hole-in-One Club

- The Hole-in-One Club is designed to reward any Golf Member (Full Golf, Signature Golf, Dual-Resident Golf, Corporate Golf, Group Company Golf and Junior Golf) who gets a hole-in-one at Signature between April 1st and October 31st that is witnessed by another person.
- All Golf Members are auto-enrolled in the Hole-in-One Club.
- All Golf Members of the Hole-in-One Club are billed \$5.00 on their monthly statement for each hole-in-one made by a Member of the Club.
 - You can opt out of the Hole-in-One Club upon request.
 - Golf Members who do opt out do not receive any of the privileges of the Hole-in-One Club.
- When a member makes a hole-in-one at Signature, all Members of the Hole-in-One Club are invited to come to the Club and enjoy a complementary drink to celebrate the ace.
- The Member who made the hole-in-one also receives a personalized plaque to commemorate the accomplishment.

Golf Shop Merchandise

- The Signature Golf Shop is a full-service shop with competitive pricing on merchandise from all of your favorite golf vendors.
 - TaylorMade, FootJoy, Callaway, Straight Down, and Johnnie-O are just some of the many brands of equipment and apparel that we carry in the Golf Shop.
- Our staff is happy to place special orders upon request if we do not have what you are looking for in stock.
- The golf staff can also assist you with corporate or group orders including golf ball customization.

Northern Ohio Golf Association

Signature of Solon Country Club is a member of the Northern Ohio Golf Association (NOGA). To allow our Golf Members to participate in the many tournaments throughout our district, we must adhere to all NOGA rules and regulations. NOGA is part of the USGA's GHIN system, a stroke control system for handicapping purposes. These procedures will also help your Golf Committee and Handicap Committee establish equitable handicaps for our Club events. The annual handicap fee for all Members is \$48 + tax and billed in the May Statement.

Handicaps in Tournament Play

Unless otherwise stated, handicaps for tournament play will be determined 2 days prior to the start of any tournament subject to changes as determined solely by the pro shop in consult with the Signature of Solon Tournament and Handicap committees.

White Tees in Tournament Play

Unless otherwise stated on the following tournament specific pages, all tournaments will be contested from the blue tees. However, white tees will be available in tournament play (except for Member / Guest Invitational) and where stated, for all men aged 70 and older OR for all men whose age + playing handicap is 85 or more. (the “**White Tee Rule**”). If you choose to use the “White Tee Rule” this must be communicated to the pro-shop **PRIOR** to the date of the event. This can be noted in the notes section of your event registration or must be submitted to the professional staff via email **PRIOR** to the date of the event.

Equitable Stroke Control

Equitable Stroke Control (ESC) is the system which limits the number of strokes a golfer may report for handicap purposes. The maximum score you can record for handicapping purposes is **NET** DOUBLE BOGEY. If you are out of a hole and pick up your ball to speed up play, mark down the score you most likely would have made. For handicap purposes, you are required to adjust your hole score (actual or probable) when it is higher than the maximum score you can post for that hole. There is no limit to the number of holes on which you can adjust your score.

***** To simplify this process, enter your score into the GHIN app hole-by-hole. The GHIN app will make the necessary adjustments. *****

Posting Scores

After completing 18 holes, the player must enter his or her adjusted score on the GHIN mobile app. In addition, scores from other courses must also be entered into the computer for your handicap computation, using your adjusted score and the course slope and rating. If you have any questions concerning any of the above procedures, please ask one of the Golf Professionals for assistance.

All 9-hole scores as well as all 18-hole scores (with 10 or more holes played) are required to be posted. If you play 10 to 17 holes, the score must be submitted in the GHIN app by selecting 10-17 holes and posting scores on the holes you played. Any unplayed holes are to be left blank and GHIN will calculate your expected score for the unplayed holes based upon your index and a course of standard difficulty.

With the implementation of the new World Handicap System in 2020, handicap indexes are updated ***daily***. Since the maximum score you can post on any given hole is now net double bogey, it is important that you confirm your handicap index on the day you played prior to posting your score.

It is important that you post your score with the proper date and course.

The Handicap Committee is fully aware the Club is to be used and enjoyed by the Members and the above-mentioned rule will not apply if a golfer enjoys a few holes while not playing under The Rules of Golf (i.e. practicing while hitting extra shots, etc.). The stroke control and posting procedures have been designed to account for all 9 and 18-hole rounds from the beginning of the golf season to the end of the golf season.

April 1st through October 31st is the active posting season in Northeast Ohio as defined by NOGA. You cannot post scores for handicap purposes for rounds played in a northern climate between November 1st and March 31st.

A Message from Your Handicap Committee

The Signature of Solon Handicap Committee is here to communicate, educate, and ensure that Signature is a healthy club, where competitions are run with everyone on an equal playing field. As previously communicated, our goal is to have every member post their scores in GHIN after every eligible round played, and to ensure they are posted correctly. In addition to communication and education, we are also auditing to ensure that members who compete in golf events and leagues at Signature of Solon are posting scores appropriately. When audits indicate that Signature of Solon members with a GHIN handicap do not post a score for a scheduled round, the committee will review and may post a score of par + 50% of the members course handicap for the round.

We realize that there are situations where you may not be able to post a score. This would usually happen when playing a format that is not eligible for posting, e.g., scrambles, playing less than 9 holes, or playing alone. If this is the case, please contact Daniel Wasinski to discuss the situation. This will have no impact for members who do not maintain a GHIN handicap for competitive purposes.

As always, please reach out to any of us on the committee if you have any questions regarding posting scores.

Course and Greens

A Message from Your Greens Committee

The primary focus of the Greens Committee is the golf course itself – the daily/weekly condition and presentation of the golf course to our members and guests and to a lesser extent, the longer-term vision of potential modifications/enhancements to the golf course in the years to come, all within the typical constraints of a corporate owned club. The Greens Committee will be the voice of our Superintendent (Kevin Barth) to the members to communicate information regarding what is expected of members and guests about taking care of our golf course (the “rules” if you will), what projects Kevin and his team are working on and have planned in the coming months, and relevant current conditions and circumstances that may impact the daily/weekly golf course conditions. Finally, the Greens Committee will liaise with the Tournament and Handicap Committees when appropriate for the betterment of the golf experience for our members and guests.

1. “Player ready” golf course daily, particularly on weekends and holidays – the committee defined this as mowed and rolled greens, fresh cups (painted white if possible) and fully raked and groomed sand traps at a minimum. We trust members have noticed that Kevin and his staff have focused on this as his plan is to mow 5-6 times a week, roll 4-5 times a week, rake, and groom traps at least 5-6 times a week and cut fresh cups 4-5 times a week.
2. Continue to reclaim the golf course from the wetlands – Those of you who have been around for years will attest to the wetlands creep that has occurred over the years and the amount of playable area we have lost. Kevin and his team have focused very hard on reclaiming many areas of the course and have a plan to continue to maintain a reasonable height of the wetland areas on the course and to keep the edges maintained to avoid additional creep.
3. Condition and safety of bridges – many of our bridges have deteriorated over the years and will require some level of repair which is a longer-term, off-season project that will be discussed at the corporate level. In the short-term, Kevin and his team over the coming weeks will be evaluating all of the bridges for potential safety concerns (i.e. nails, slick surfaces when wet, etc.) and plans to install a traction product on certain bridges to improve safety.
4. Penalty area/OB marking - The committee discussed the importance of enhancing the penalty area and out-of-bounds marking of the golf course and will liaise with the tournament committee and the professional staff on this to ensure consistency and

regularity of marking the golf course. Members should understand that stakes are visual indicators of the approximate location of a penalty area or out of bounds line. The actual painted lines represent the exact location of the hazard line or out of bounds line.

5. Golf course signage – Please respect without exception the signage incorporated to the golf course last year, which includes where cart traffic is restricted, where carts should enter and exit fairways and for drop areas, etc. Carts should be kept **OUT OF THE ROUGH** at all times except to enter and exit the fairway at designated points.
6. Kevin and his team plan to work with the corporate team to develop a long-term plan to improve drainage in traps throughout the golf course. This is no small task and will take some time, so we ask for patience from members on this point.
7. Expectations of all golf members and their guests – The committee spent significant time discussing what should be communicated to the membership regarding expected conduct, including that of guests. Following are the basic things we can all do to help Kevin, and his staff present the golf course to us and our guests in the best condition possible:
 - a. **Always check-in with the Pro Shop before teeing off.**
 - b. Next and most important – leave the golf course in better condition than how you found it –
 - i. This starts on the first tee box – be sure to pick up your tee even if broken and any others on the tee box. Do this on every hole and do not leave tees in the ground as they damage mower blades.
 - ii. Fill your divot with sand (or replace turf if intact). We have all gotten very frustrated to hit a perfect drive and then find it in a divot in the fairway. Fill your divot and 2-3 more. If we all do this, the problem will be solved.
 - iii. Rake sand traps – Same as above – we have all hit a shot into the trap only to find it in an unraked footprint. Rake the sand that you have disturbed like a professional caddy. Make sure you leave the area in better condition than you found it and don't be afraid to rake areas that someone else ignored. Rakes should be left in bunkers aligned in direction of play.
 - iv. Fix your ball mark! We understand sometimes it is hard to find your own ball mark. Make it a habit to fix at least 2-3 on every green including your own.
 - c. Golf carts should always remain on the cart path on all par 3 holes from tee to green. This is obvious to most of us but needs to be restated so everyone understands this expectation.

-
- d. Golf carts should generally be kept **IN THE FAIRWAY** and **OUT OF THE ROUGH**. Obviously except when conditions require cart path only, unless otherwise restricted (#16 for example) carts should enter the fairway from the cart path at the marked spot and should stay in the fairway and out of the rough as the hole is played ultimately exiting the fairway at the marked spot near the green. Kevin and his staff are working hard to improve the rough areas and keeping carts out of the rough will help improve the condition and consistency of the rough over time.
 - e. Golf carts should never be driven near green – Carts should always be driven no closer than 30-40 feet (10-15 strides) to the greens and should NEVER be driven in the rough up near any greens – most notable violations of this are generally the left side of #2, the left and right side of #14, etc.

The Greens Committee plans to meet approximately monthly throughout the year and will continue periodic communications to the membership. We welcome all feedback and are happy to provide additional clarity on any of these points as may be needed.

Leagues

Signature of Solon Country Club offers several leagues that can accommodate many groups and levels of play. It is our goal to integrate as many Members into the Club as possible. Our leagues are a great way to meet other people, have fun, and build relationships in a friendly and relaxed setting.

S.W.in.G. – Tuesday Morning

S.W.in.G. stands for Signature Women in Golf and is the Tuesday morning ladies league. There is an annual fee to join S.W.in.G. Different games and competitions are scheduled each week with winners paid out in Golf Shop Credit Book. There is a 9-hole group and an 18-hole group that plays each week. You can sign up online via the ForeTees app.

Men's League – Wednesday Evening

Men's League is a 9-hole league that plays each Wednesday evening during the golf season. Play begins with a 6:00 pm shotgun start, and alternate play between the front nine and the back nine every other week. There is no fee to join the league. The weekly entry fee is \$10 / person plus applicable cart fee. You can sign up online via the ForeTees app.

- **May 13th:** Men's League Warm-Up Night
- **May 20th:** Men's League Opening Night
- **Sept. 16th:** Men's League Closing Night

Ladies League – Thursday Evening

Ladies League is a 9-hole league that plays each Thursday evening during the golf season. Play begins with a 6:00 pm shotgun start, and alternate play between the front nine and the back nine. There is no fee to join the league. The weekly entry fee is \$10/person plus applicable cart fee. You can sign up online via the ForeTees app.

- **May 14th:** Ladies League Warm-Up Night
- **May 21st:** Ladies League Opening Night
- **Sept. 17th:** Ladies League Closing Night

Couples 9 and Dine – Friday Evening

Couples 9 and Dine is a 9-hole weekly event that plays each Friday evening during the golf season. Play begins with a 6:00 pm shotgun start. Light hors d'oeuvres are offered to participants at the halfway house starting at 5:30 pm. There is no fee to join the league. The weekly entry fee is \$10/couple plus applicable cart fee. You can sign up online via the ForeTees app.

- **May 15th:** Couples League Warm-Up Night
- **May 22nd:** Couples League Opening Night
- **Sept. 18th:** Couples League Closing Night

Men's Game – Sunday Morning Quota Game

The Sunday Morning Men's Quota Game is an 18-hole game that is played each Sunday during the golf season. Play begins with an 8:00 am shotgun start. This is a cash game with a mandatory cash buy-in and 100% cash payout. The entry fee is \$15 (\$60 a team). Your quota will change on a weekly basis based upon your score the previous week. If you score 3 points above your quota, it will increase by 1. Scoring 4 or more points above quota will result in your quota increasing by 2 for the following week. If you are 4 or more above quota will have a chance to collect an extra \$5(or more) from those who score 4 or more under quota. The same goes for shooting under quota, 3 under quota will drop your quota by 1. 4 or more under quota will result in your quota dropping by 2 points and will be subject to a \$5 nuisance fee. You can sign up online via the ForeTees app.

- **May 10th:** Men's Sunday Quota Game Opening Day
- **Sept. 18th:** Men's Sunday Quota Game Closing Day

So, What's New in 2026?

A LOT!

Signups for all events will open 2 months prior to the event. **Member Guest Sign-ups will still take place on Saturday, March 28th at 9:00am EST.**

If you choose to use the “**White Tee Rule**” it is your responsibility to have this communicated to the pro-shop **PRIOR** to the date of the event. This can be noted in the notes section of your event registration or must be submitted to the professional staff via email **PRIOR** to the date of the event.

April 5 Buddy/Buddy and Signature Cup Match Play

Round 1 for both Buddy/Buddy and Signature Cup Match Play will open on Sunday, April 5th and run until the official Play Day on Sunday, May 24th. There is zero excuse for not getting your match scheduled within a 7-week period. Play by the play day or face disqualification.

May 16-17 Ringer Tournament

A Ringer Tournament lets players build their best-ever scorecard over multiple rounds by picking their lowest gross and net score for *each hole*, creating one ideal 18-hole "ringer" score by the end of the event. Day 1 low gross and net will be paid out along with Day 2 low gross and low net and Day 1 and 2 total low gross and low net. This will be a two man team event.

June 13-14 Spring Member / Member

The even format and holes played in the shootout are different this year. Round 1 will be Scramble followed by Best Ball in Round 2. Round 3 will remain Modified Alternate Shot. The shootout will take place on holes 1,3,4, and 18.

June 20-21 Senior Club Championship

Along with the overall winner, low net and low gross for both day 1 and day 2 will be paid out. Even if you have a difficult Saturday, come back on Sunday and give it your all and secure a little shop credit by being low gross or low net!

We will also have a ladies flight this year! Any and all of our female golf members aged 50 or over are invited to participate. You must have a USGA handicap to register for the event.

July 18 Ladies Guest Day

Ladies Guest Day is now on a weekend! Work is no longer an issue for you, we would love to see a full field of ladies out for our annual Ladies Guest Day!

July 23-25 Men's Member Guest Invitational
